

Recommendations

Connections

- 1 Provide park connection to future Ballan Road development and future regional park.
- 2 Provide new path to define event space and provide direct connection to Werribee River path.
- 3 Provide new path connections to provide new Parkrun or cross country routes of a set distance eg 1km (orange)/1.5km (blue)/2km (mauve)
- 4 Improve pedestrian connections to the west to address the perceived barriers created by existing sporting infrastructure.
- 5 Strengthen links to the important north - south connection along the Werribee River shared trail
- 6 Construct a 3m wide shared path along the western boundary
- 7 Car park extension to serve upgraded softball and hockey facilities.
- 8 Reconfigure and extend existing car park to include WSUD initiatives and provide tree planting.
- 9 Seal existing road and install speed control devices to limit dust and disturbance to dog club, and improve the entry to the dog club.
- 10 Provide additional formal car parking adjacent to the dog off leash area.

Organised Sporting / Recreation Activities

- 11 Reorient softball fields with compliant back net fencing player dugouts, outfields with irrigation and drainage, and no skinned infields or home run fencing required, to provide central open fields (100m x 70m with 5m all round).
- 12 Four main softball fields to be reoriented, rebuilt with compliant back net and home run fencing (76.2m) player dugouts, skinned infields, and outfields with irrigation and drainage. Install training standard floodlights to Show Pitches 1 and 2
- 13 Install a softball hatching cage.
- 14 Central planted space for shelter during non playing times. New spectator shelter for up to 100 people.
- 15 Softball overflow allowance on southern baseball diamonds during tournaments.
- 16 New multi-use court for unorganised fitness and active youth space.
- 17 Modify hockey/softball pavilion to accommodate future growth of the clubs and to facilitate efficient and effective joint use.
- 18 Install a new full size hockey pitch, including LED floodlighting, spectator seating (west side), player dugouts and a technical bench (east side), a new maintenance shed.
- 19 Renew floodlighting at end of asset life.
- 20 Overflow area.
- 21 Upgrade baseball pavilion.
- 22 Install compliant netting to baseball diamonds, and provide additional undercover viewing areas.
- 23 Install training standard lighting to Diamond 1 and future proof for an upgrade to competition standard that would include club contribution. Install training standard lighting to Diamond 2.
- 24 Formalise dog obedience fence to Heaths Road frontage.
- 25 Upgrade / replace the existing irrigation system of the dog training area, convert the surface to Kikuyu, and extend the area to the east.
- 26 Modify the Dog Obedience pavilion to provide externally accessible unisex public toilets.
- Environment**
- 27 Provide additional planting (and bollards or similar) for shelter/buffer and traffic control.
- 28 Enhance lake edge with new planting, paths/boardwalk, shelters and seats.
- 29 Enhance existing open drain and bore through planting and/or water retention.
- 30 Enhance and extend existing planting areas and provide new habitat areas.
- 31 Continue to enhance and enlarge the habitat linkages along the Werribee River and create new habitat linkages along drainage lines.
- Events**
- 32 Widen existing path to provide a stable event management/setup route.
- 33 Define event spaces.
- 34 Define event parking areas.
- 35 Provide flexible gathering points with 3 phase power and water for events, functioning also as picnic and seating areas.
- Recreation**
- 36 Provide a new play area to support new rectangular field, and hockey and softball activities, allowing for intergenerational play when families come together for sporting events.
- 37 Upgrade the existing playground, including public toilet to a regional all abilities play space, including both nature play and challenge play.
- 38 Provide a pump track.
- 39 Provide an outdoor fitness facility.
- 40 Provide shared trail loops with distance markers and support facilities for walking and jogging.
- 41 Extend the dog off leash area to create a quiet dog area with a drinking fountain and bowl and additional natural shade.
- Arts and Culture**
- 42 Create an arts/heritage trail with public art and interpretive signage of significant cultural heritage and environmental values.
