TARNEIT MAJOR TOWN CENTRE – URBAN DESIGN FRAMEWORK



June 2023



PROJECT BACKGROUND:

Tarneit is going through a period of rapid change and growth. Wyndham City Council has developed an Urban Design Framework that will help shape the design, development and growth of the Tarneit Major Town Centre.

The Urban Design Framework (UDF) will help to ensure the town centre meets the needs of the growing population in Tarneit with the centre ultimately providing a capacity of 8,000 jobs and a home to more than 10,000 people.

The UDF will be a guide for staged development in the area and for attracting investment over the next 30 years.

The purpose of this engagement was to seek community feedback on the UDF and to determine the level of community support.

Consultation was open via The Loop from Monday 20th February until Monday 20th March 2023, a duration of four (4) weeks.



METHODOLOGY:

The below table outlines the various methods and techniques used to engage with the community.

Excited to have more shopping, parks and other community services closer to us." "Looks great, love that it is aimed to be a place of economic prosperity and culture."

Is there anything we might have missed that you think should be included?	Feedback on this item was consistent that people want development of the area to occur as soon as possible.
	People want Council to bring in and advocate for large retail chains for extra shopping opportunities.
	There is also consistent feedback that a hospital is required for this part of Wyndham.
	There has been concern with the current public transport options, whether it be rail or bus services as they are either not available or frequent enough and are hoping the UDF can provide more for an emerging population centre.
	You want more trees and open spaces but also opportunities to take recreation indoors.




Town Core Character area	Average of 4.4 out of 5 from a total of 12 responses.

NEXT STEPS:

- Council will use the feedback provided by this consultation to influence outcomes in the draft UDF.
- The UDF document will be further refined throughout the rest of 2023 with the aim for final authorisation in late 2023/start of 2024. The start of development for the first stages would occur shortly afterwards.
- Some feedback provided was out of scope of what the UDF can influence however this feedback is valuable as it shows Council that there are factors within the community that are also important. Some of this feedback included:
 - o Construction of roads and increase of road capacity outside of the UDF boundaries.
 - o Building railway stations along the Regional Rail Link.
 - o Development of specific retail businesses
 - o Development of activity centres outside the UDF boundaries.
